A Statement of Dissolution is used to terminate a
Maryland Limited Liability Partnership (LLP)

Checks payable to "SDAT" (State Department of Assessments and Taxation)

- (1) Insert the **name of the LLP** exactly as registered with SDAT, including all punctuation and the tail (i.e., "LLP" or "Limited Liability Partnership", etc.).
- (2) If known, insert the **SDAT ID number**. If unknown, please leave blank.
- (3) This **required statement** must be in your Statement of Dissolution. Please do not remove, do not cross out.
- (4) The Statement of Dissolution **must be signed** by a partner who has not wrongfully dissociated, OR, by another person authorized by Title 9a, Corp & Assns Code.

Important Note

- All fields are required under Maryland law.
- Incomplete or incorrect forms will be rejected and cause delays.
- Extra information may be added if you believe it is relevant.
- Forms must be typed or clearly printed in black ink.
